We are packing our bags once again. After a lot of prayer and consideration, we have decided to return to Israel on Friday morning. We have had many opportunities to share our faith with Israelis here in Cyprus who fled the war, but many of these Israelis have now returned to Israel (not because it is safe, but because it is expensive for them to stay in Cyprus without a way to have income). Our purpose for going back is:

- (1) to continue ministering to Israelis during the war (backpackers we met in South America, people we met in our building when the war started, etc.)
- (2) to provide humanitarian aid to those in need (soldiers, the elderly, those displaced by the war, those on the northern and southern borders of Israel, etc.). We will join the efforts of Chosen People Ministries in Israel to pack food and supplies for those in need.

Please continue to pray for peace in Israel and the salvation of the Jewish people. Please pray for our safety as we will be traveling more in Israel to participate in service projects.

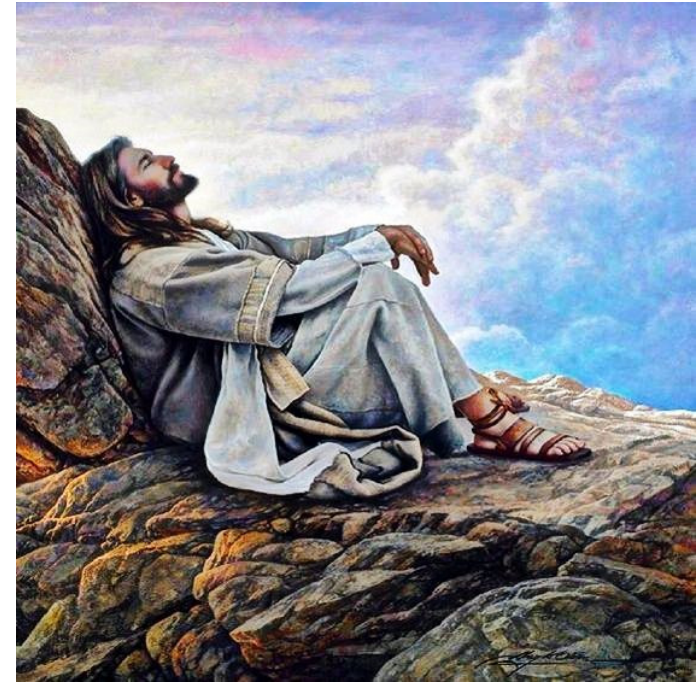
